AETC Form 635, 20010801 (EF-V1), Easement for Pipeline Right-of-Way, FC 3290, AETCI 32-9001. Form is used when allowing the use of Air Force property by other entities for the purpose of constructing, operating, or maintaining a gas, water, or sewer pipeline. Previous editions are obsolete.

AETC Form 636, 20010801 (EF-V1), Easement for Road or Street, FC 3290, AETCI 32-9001. Form is used when allowing the use of Air Force property by other entities for the purpose of constructing, operating, or maintaining a road or street, as authorized by 10 USC 2668. Previous editions are obsolete.

AETC Form 637, 20010801 (EF-V1), Easement for Right-of-Way for Electrical Transmission or Communications Facilities, FC 3290, AETCI 32-9001. Form is used when allowing the use of Air Force property by other entities for the purpose of providing electrical transmission or communications services. Previous editions are obsolete.

AETC Form 639, 20010801 (EF-V1), License, FC 3290, AETCI 32-9001. Form is a standard real estate license used when allowing the use of Air Force properties by non-Federal government agencies, commercial entities, and other miscellaneous organizations. Previous editions are obsolete.
