**AFRSI 36-2101**, Air Force Recruiting Service Personnel Actions, HQ AFRS/RSXP, F. It establishes policies and procedures pertaining to manning of authorized recruiter and recruiting support positions, permanent changes of station, permanent changes of assignment, and personnel programs within Air Force Recruiting Service. It also establishes policies and procedures pertaining to recruiter opportunities as recruiter instructor at the Air Force Recruiting School and recruiter inspector duty with the AETC Inspector General. ATCR 39-14, 1 December 1989, will be rescinded when this instruction is published.

**AFRSI 38-201**, Air Force Recruiting Service Operational Organization, HQ AFRS/RSXXM, F. It establishes guidance on submission of manpower authorization change requests and organizational change requests within HQ AFRS, the four recruiting groups, and 28 recruiting squadrons. AETCI 38-201, 15 February 1996, will be rescinded when this instruction is published.

**AFRSI 90-201**, Air Force Recruiting Service (AFRS) Inspection Programs, HQ AFRS/RSO, F. It establishes requirements for the AFRS squadron inspection program and staff assistance visit program. It applies to all levels of command within AFRS. AETCI 90-201, 20 December 1996, will be rescinded when this instruction is published.
