NOTE 1: This supplement applies to all AETC clubs, club annexes, and all other Services activities (such as bowling center snack bars, base restaurants, marinas, etc.) that sell or serve alcoholic beverages.

NOTE 2: Maintain and dispose of records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication in accordance with AFMAN 37-139, *Records Disposition Schedule*.

1.4.1. In addition to beverage supervisors and servers, the training program will also apply to bartenders, bar backs, and food and beverage service staff.

1.5.1.8. Regular coupons may be used in the lounges, but must not specifically target alcoholic beverages.

1.5.2.2.9. (Added) Encourage patrons to select a designated driver and identify patron-selected designated drivers with pins, shirts, jackets, etc. Designated drivers may consume free nonalcoholic beverages of their choice (determined by the club manager) during the period of time they are designated drivers. To encourage the use of the designated driver program, managers should consider an incentive program whereby a unit with an exceptional program could receive recognition.

1.9. In addition, do not display charts, graphs, or pictorials that compare body size and weight to the volume of alcohol consumed.

2.1.6. Provide a copy of the base supplement to HQ AETC/SVPB after publishing.

2.1.8. Examples of onbase areas include flight lines, parks, picnic areas, etc., which may support events such as air shows, base open houses, and other like events.

2.5. This applies to golf courses (including driving ranges and clubhouses).

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
