AFOOSH Standard 48-14, 1 April 1996, is supplemented as follows:

This supplement applies to all AETC recreational swimming pools. It does not apply to the Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve Command. Maintain and dispose of records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication in accordance with AFMAN 37-139, *Records Disposition Schedule*.

1.2.6. Lifeguards will receive training on the Bloodborne Pathogens Standard; and, if they have not already been vaccinated, will be offered Hepatitis B vaccine within 10 days of their initial assignment. For information on the coverage of lifeguards as emergency responders in 29 CFR 1910.1030, Bloodborne Pathogens Standard, see <http://www.psha.gov> under Interpretations and then Coverage of Lifeguards, July 9, 1993.

2.1.5.1. Another reason for conducting pre-season inspections at least 30 days prior to opening of the pools is to ensure all equipment is available.
