**TO 1C-130A-21, 1 September 1999, is supplemented as follows in accordance with the provisions of TO 00-5-1, *Air Force Technical Order System*:**

***SUMMARY OF REVISIONS***

**This publication is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.** This revision provides changes only to listed specific aircraft Dash 21/loose equipment quantities and quantities for nonlisted items required for AETC training mission on HC-130P, MC-130H, and MC-130P aircraft. This supplement does not list any equipment not under the control or responsibility of maintenance organizations; for example, forward area refuel point (FARP) equipment, life support gear, etc.

***NOTES:***

1. All AETC units will maintain this publication in current status and make reference to it on the title page and each affected paragraph of the basic TO. This supplement does not apply to AETC-gained Air Force Reserve Command or Air National Guard units. File this supplement behind the basic TO and retain it until revised or rescinded by HQ AETC. Recommendations for change, improvement, or waivers to this supplement should be annotated on AETC Form 1236, **Request for Improving/Changing AETC Maintenance Regulations/Instructions**. Requests must be approved by the appropriate group commander (or squadron commander, if not assigned to a group) prior to forwarding to HQ AETC/LGMMP, 555 E Street East, Randolph AFB TX 78150-4440, for action by HQ AETC/LGM.
2. Maintain and dispose of records created as a result or processes prescribed in this publication in accordance with AFMAN 37-139, *Records Disposition Schedule* (will become

AFMAN 33-322, Volume 4).

3. This supplement covers each AETC mission design series (MDS) separately. The listed equipment is broken down into three sections: Table 1-1, Maintenance Safety and Protection Equipment; Table 1-2, Alternate Mission Equipment; and Table 1-3, Crew and Passenger Support Equipment.

4. Items in the "item #" column in each table of this supplement correspond to the item # in that table of the basic TO. If there is a quantity in the HC-130P, MC-130H, or MC-130P columns, it is a *change* to the quantities in the basic TO table. However, if there is a dash in any of these columns, there is *no change* from the quantity listed in the basic TO for that column. (For items not listed at all in this supplement, their quantities remain as shown in the basic TO.)
